Inviting the best possible providers into our community and supporting them is essential to ensuring access to high-quality care. In 2023, we added 117 providers in areas such as Anesthesiology, Cardiology, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Critical Care, Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Intraoperative Neurology, Nephrology, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Pediatrics, Plastic Surgery, Podiatry, Pulmonary/Sleep Medicine, Psychiatry, Radiology, Urology, and Vascular Surgery.

We strive to create an environment where talent is recognized, job satisfaction is valued and our 1,950 employees can effectively use their skills to provide high-quality care and service.

St. Francis-Emory Healthcare is proud to take a leadership role in addressing the disparities some experience when seeking healthcare. These disparities can be found in all areas of our community and can be based on factors that include race, gender, age, mental illness, homelessness, and socioeconomic status. We are focusing our efforts on several disparities, including maternal health for African American women, access to crisis services for persons experiencing mental illness, and support of United Way activities and other community partnerships. For example, St. Francis-Emory is working hand-in-hand with Feeding the Valley to refer appropriate patients to a new grant-funded program providing free food and education to people with congestive heart failure, using "food as medicine" to generate improved health in those with chronic cardiac conditions.

Future projections indicate a clear need for qualified physicians for the Chattahoochee Valley and ensuring we stay ahead of workforce needs continues to be a major focus. Our Internal Medicine and Psychiatry Residency Programs have 44 physician residents from all over the country currently being guided and mentored by our trusted faculty. Our goal is simple, to cultivate leadership and professionalism, and establish a firm foundation for the next generation of physicians dedicated to providing high-quality healthcare to best serve our communities.
